Due to the current financial climate The Community Council has had to look very closely at the running cost of the Village Hall in Is-y-coed. I am sure you will be aware of the high increase in energy costs, the village hall's running costs are no different to the rest of us. With this said the Community Council have had to review the hall's hire tariff and have reluctantly had to adjust these to cover the running costs.

It is with regret that some of these costs have to be passed onto the persons who hire the hall.

We feel sure you will agree the small increase is not unreasonable under the current financial climate.

The hall is available for hire in 4 hour blocks, each 4 hour block will incur a charge of £40 per session for village residents and £50 for non village residents

Block bookings will be entitled to a percentage discount, the clerk of the council will be happy to discuss this at the time of the booking.

Wrexham U3A has been in existence for more than 15 years, though the movement started 40 years ago!! It is a voluntary organisation for people who are retired or in part-time employment.

Essentially it is a self help movement where the members initiate and originate and develop a variety of activities according to the members' interests and involvement. Wrexham U3A currently has over 300 members who pay an annual fee, usually less than £20, to be involved. Membership offers a monthly talk at the Wrexham Memorial Hall, each month on a different topic, six editions during the year of the Wrexham U3A newsletter, and membership to any number of the 40 interest groups, details of which can be found on the Wrexham U3A website. Activities vary, but include: badminton sessions, Crown green bowling, Bridge, book reading, Canasta, dining groups, dog walking, walking groups (different levels of difficulty) local history, music appreciation, Scrabble, poetry, cinema and theatre visits to name just a few

Currently this writer is involved in ten different groups - all managed in different ways by the group leaders but each providing a different involvement and social enjoyment at every stage. One member had interest in the oriental past-time of "Mah-Jong" and so we formed a group to develop that interest and now it flourishes! Most activities occur in the morning or afternoon but some, like theatre productions may be evening based.

A friendly welcome awaits any Wrexhamian who comes along with interest to the Wrexham Memorial Hall on the third Tuesday of every month from 1.30pm and seeks information.
